



Making a Testimonial Video

Below are some guidelines to assist you with creating your testimonial.

Setting Up The Shot

- Be sure your web cam is set up so that you are framed nicely. Closer is better, but be sure we can see your entire smiling face!
- Do you have good lighting beyond just the reflection of the computer screen?
- Being close to the webcam and microphone will help get the clearest sound possible.
- Turn off external sources of sound such as fans or air conditioning, background music or amp noise for best audio results.

Your Testimonial

- First, start by sharing your name or student user name, where you are from, and how long you have been enrolled in TTSB ("My name is John Doe, I'm from London, England, and I have been a student on the Tony Trischka School of Banjo for six months.")

Then tell us some things about you and your playing...

- How important is music in your life?
- How long have you been playing the banjo?
- What kind of training have you had prior to enrolling in the TTSB?
For example, without including instructor names, "I took lessons from a banjo teacher at my local music store," or "I have been taking free lessons on YouTube," or "I have used method books and DVDs"

... and some things about your experience in the school

- How has the TTSB made a difference in your playing?
- What kind of comments have you received on your playing since you began your lessons?
- What do you think of the ArtistWorks video exchange learning approach?
- What appeals to you about learning from Tony Trischka?
- What do you think your future playing will be like as a result of your experience here?

Submitting the Video
